Year 3 Topic trip – local area walk (second trip)

Next week, the Year Three teachers and Ms Nicol will be taking the children on a second walk around our local area. We will be focussing on Woolwich.

Thursday 4th October 2018. The children will return to school before the end of the school day.

We're hoping for lovely weather and are going to take a relaxing walk. We will be stopping for lunch in the playground of our newly opened campus, Vincent Road. The most important part of our journey will be to travel across the River Thames and back on the Woolwich Ferry. This is a historic event for our children, as these two ferries are to be decommissioned the next day and replaced with newly built ferries near the end of the year. These ferries have been in service since 1968 and have carried out 40 years of service. Teachers will be talking to the children about the landmarks and some local history and geography we have already discussed in class.

Please send your children with a packed lunch and drink, sensible walking shoes and a coat in case of any rain.

Please also send a plastic shopping bag in their lunch bag in case the ground/seats are wet.
