Can you work out these famous landmarks using the clues?

I spy with my little eye a tall pyramidal shape with slightly curved sides made of iron. In this capital city 'bonjour' is how you say 'hello'.

I spy with my little eye a large amphitheater in what once was a great empire. This capital city hosted events like gladiatorial games.

I spy with my little eye a large glass Pyramid which is the entry to the home of the Mona Lisa.

I spy with my little eye a rectangular brick building with six arched windows. Outside it isn't that exciting but inside its walls and ceiling are decorated with **frescoes** (Use a dictionary or Google to find out what a fresco is).
