

Cut out each of the boxes below or copy them out onto separate pieces of paper. (The key words and definitions are jumbled up).

Have a go at playing some of the games below. You could do this with any key vocabulary or spelling lists.

Transformation	Moving from side to side / up and down
Coordinate	pattern of shapes that fit perfectly together
Translate	2 numbers (or letters) that help locate a point
Tessellation	x and y lines that cross at right angles to make a graph
Axis	Changing the size or position of a shape

Game ideas

Hide and seek - Have an adult hide the words around the house. Call out a definition for the child to go and find (or vice versa)

Musical statues - Play some music with the boxes above laid out on the floor. When the music stops the child has to match the pairs.

Musical statues 2 - Play some music with either definitions or key words laid on the floor. When the music stops the child has to stand on a 'definition' and call out the correct 'key word'.

Snap - Use 2 or more copies of each and turn into snap. Take turns to lay cards down 'snap' when the key word and definition match.

Pumpkin Pie - Take it in turns to spell each key word letter by letter. If you get a letter wrong you are out. If you get to the end of the whole word take it in turns to say 'pumpkin' and then 'pie' - whoever says 'pie' is out! (The children enjoy playing this game in class)
