



Over the last two weeks, your children have been writing a narrative based on the short animation, “The Oceanmaker”. We thought you would like to see their work, so we have put this video together for your viewing pleasure.

The writing develops over a series of sessions: watching the animation; breaking the story into sections or ‘scenes’; harvesting vocabulary to match each scene; writing a first draft of the scene; editing the writing.

At the end of each paragraph, the children have the opportunity to share their writing and ideas, listening to feedback from their teachers and editing as they go.

The result, we hope you will agree, is a collection of fantastic, imaginative and often moving writing, of which we (and the children) are very proud.

We have also had some fantastic pieces of writing sent to us from the children who are learning at home – if you haven’t yet had a go at the ‘Stories of Water’ project on myOn, why not watch the video and use it to help you write your own version of “The Oceanmaker”.
