

The inflatable dome gave the children the chance to view the night sky and travel by rocket to the end of the universe. The dome staff narrated the journey as we travelled through space passing the Sun, Earth, Moon and all the planets in our solar system. The children were also shown videos of lunar launches and the Mars Space Rover (which we learnt would fit inside our classroom). On returning to

the classroom, the children used the inspirational visit to complete writing, art and science objectives.



#### Year 2's visit from the recycling centre

In celebration of World Earth Day, Year 2 had a special visit from Royal Greenwich Recycling workers. They spoke to the children about the importance of the three R's (reducing, re-using and recycling) and they reminded them how to correctly sort our rubbish into the correct bins.

The children had a wonderful time playing games and learning lots about how to tidy up our planet! To congratulate the children on becoming 'junior environment champions', they all received a special certificate, activity pack, bag and water bottle (re-usable of course!)

The children have loved looking at photographs of their day and it's been wonderful hearing them talk about their experiences.

In addition to this, Year 4 particularly enjoyed learning about and exploring volcanos and earthquakes. They were able to experience what is was like during the 1995 earthquake in Kobe, Japan, on the earthquake stimulator.


The children have really enjoyed this term's Science topic and can tell you
