Please have a look at just **SOME** of the things we will be learning in the Spring term.

Personal, Social and Emotional

- We are going to welcome and make friends with children who are new to nursery.
- We are going to care for others and learn how we care for animals.
- We are going to develop our independence skills.
- We will continue to develop our sharing and turn taking skills.

Physical development

- We are going to practice using pens and pencils correctly to form some letters in our name.
- We will continue to develop our cutting skills using scissors.
- We will use our bodies to move in different ways when moving like different animals.
- We will put on our coats all by ourselves and do them up too.

Communication, Language and Literacy

- We will listen to stories and recall, joining in with repeated phrases
- We will retell stories too in our own words.
- We will differentiate between different sounds and identify where they are coming from.
- We will begin to segment and blend sounds in words orally
- We will begin to learn the sounds that some letters make.
- We will ascribe meanings to marks when mark making.
- We will begin to write our names.

Mathematics

- We will practice counting as far as we can with one to one correspondence.
- We will begin to recognise numeral 1-5, 6-10 and then to 20.
- We are going to match amount to numeral.
- We will explore and name 2d and 3d shapes when making pictures and models.
- We will develop our understanding of positional language such as behind, in front, next to, in -between, under and on top of
- We will order 3 sizes big, medium and large.

Understanding the world

- We will talk about our environment and how to take care of it.
- We will name and talk about animals and observe their features; what they look like, what they sound like, where they live, who are their babies.
- We will learn about different celebrations.

Expressive arts and design

- We will move our bodies in different ways to music when being animals.
- We will tap out syllables in our names and simple rhythms using different parts of our bodies and percussion instruments.
- We will sing lots of songs and rhymes
- We are going to create pictures and models using different materials.
- We are going to engage in role play such as a vets and pet shop.
